LAUNCH PROCEDURES

1. BCBS Facilitator to hold a meeting with the Principal and the "Safe School" Teacher Committee, or "Designate" to educate them on the program and help them to set the critical path based on pre-arranged school assembly dates.

NOTE: this should be done at least 2-3 days prior to the first assembly of the school year.

- 2. Safe School Designate to hold an information session with the Parents Association (if possible), and the School Staff group to educate each group on the program.
- 3. Safe School Designate to work with the school Principal (or VP) to establish all-inclusive recess planning and execution dates. Monthly champions will work with Principal, or Designate, and Facilitator to plan and execute each recess.

- 4. Safe School Designate to show the LAUNCH VIDEO at the first all-school assembly of the year, as well as the first attribute/super power video clip, which is RESPECT.
- 5. Teachers to hold introduction sessions with students to engender understanding and engagement by having students brainstorm examples.
- 6. Safe School Designate to run the BCBS Program as per the critical path.
